 11 WHEREAS, the Aging Services Bureau in the Department of *Hend*
 12 Social and Rehabilitation Services was eliminated in 1981;
 13 and
 14 WHEREAS, Montana's senior citizens see a need for an
 15 administrative structure in state government with the
 16 ability to provide a clear focus for program issues relating
 17 specifically to senior citizens; and
 18 WHEREAS, several options may be acceptable, but
 19 in-depth analysis is required to assure that a well-reasoned
 20 proposal can be put before the Legislature.
 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
 22 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 23 That an appropriate interim committee be assigned to
 24 study the options for administration of programs to meet the
 25 needs of Montana's aging.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee analysis
 2 include consideration of creating a Department of Aging,
 3 Commission on Aging, or a Board or Bureau of Aging among
 4 other options that may be considered.
 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee submit a
 6 complete implementation plan, along with its recommendation,
 7 to the 49th Legislature.
 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee work with
 9 the Coordinator of Aging and the Advisory Council on Aging
 10 in conducting its work.
