1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
.2	Section 1. Section 15-70-101, MCA, is amended to read:
13	*15-70-101. Disposition of funds. All taxes, interest,
14	and penalties collected under this chapter shall be turned
15	over promptly to the state treasurer who shall place the
.6	same in the earmarked revenue fund to the credit of the
١7	department of highways, except those funds hereinbelow
8	allocated to cities, towns, and counties, which funds shall
19	be paid by the state treasurer directly to such cities,
20	towns, and counties.
21	(1) \$6,500,000 of the funds collected under this
22	chapter shall be allocated each fiscal year on a monthly
23	basis to the counties and incorporated cities and towns in
24	Montana for construction, reconstruction, maintenance, and

repair of rural roads and city or town streets and alleys or

1	for the purchase or repair of capital equipment necessary
2	for those purposes, as provided in subsections (a) and (b)
3	hereof:
4	(a) \$2,950,000 shall be divided among the various
5	counties in the following manner:
6	(i) 40% in the ratio that the rural road mileage in
7	each county, exclusive of the federal-aid interstate system
8	and the federal-aid primary system, bears to the total rural
9	road mileage in the state, exclusive of the federal-aid
10	interstate system and the federal-aid primary system;
11	(ii) 40% in the ratio that the rural population in each
12	county outside incorporated cities and towns bears to the
13	total rural population in the state outside incorporated
14	cities and towns;
15	(ili) 20% in the ratio that the land area of each
16	county bears to the total land area of the state;
17	(b) \$3,550,000 shall be divided among the incorporated
18	cities and towns in the following manner:
19	(i) 50% of the sum in the ratio that the population
20	within the corporate limits of the city or town bears to the
21	total population within corporate limits of all the cities
22	and towns in Montana;
23	(ii) 50% in the ratio that the city or town street and
24	alley mileage, exclusive of the federal-aid interstate
25	system and the federal-aid primary system, within corporate

limits bears to the total street and alley mileage, exclusive of the federal-aid interstate system and federal-aid primary system, within the corporate limits of all cities and towns in Montana.

and towns shall be used exclusively for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance, and repair of rural roads, city or town streets and alleys: for the purchase or repair of capital equipment necessary for those purposes: or for the share which such city, town, or county might otherwise expend for proportionate matching of federal funds allocated for the construction of roads or streets which are part of the federal-ald primary or secondary highway system or urban extensions thereto.

(3) Upon receipt of the allocation provided herein, the governing bodies of the recipient counties, cities, and towns shall inform the department of highways of the purposes for which the funds will be expended so that the county commissioners, the governing body, and the department of highways may coordinate the expenditure of public funds for road improvements.

(4) All funds hereby allocated to counties, cities, and towns shall be disbursed to the lowest responsible bidder according to applicable bidding procedures followed in all cases where the contract for construction,

reconstruction, maintenance, or repair is in excess of \$4,000.

3 (5) For the purposes of this section where 4 distribution of funds is made on a basis related to 5 population, the population shall be determined by the last 6 preceding official federal census.

(6) For the purposes of this section where determination of mileage is necessary for distribution of funds, it shall be the responsibility of the cities, towns, and counties to furnish to the department of highways and state treasurer a yearly certified statement indicating the total mileage within their respective areas applicable to this chapter. All mileage submitted shall be subject to review and approval by the department of highways.
