5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PERMIT THE MONTANA
6 HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO DELEGATE ITS AUTHORITY TO AWARD
7 CONTRACTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS AND TO UNITS OF
8 LOCAL GOVERNMENT; AMENDING SECTION 60-2-111, MCA."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 60-2-111, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "60-2-111. Letting of contracts on state and
13 federal-aid highways. ~~At~~ ~~(1) Except as provided in~~
14 ~~subsection (2), all~~ contracts for work on state and
15 federal-aid highways, including portions in cities and
16 towns, and all contracts entered into under 7-14-4108 shall
17 be let by the commission. Except as otherwise specifically
18 provided, the commission may enter such types of contracts
19 and upon such terms as it may decide. All contracts shall
20 meet the requirements of Title 18, chapter 2, part 4. When
21 there is no prevailing rate of wages set by collective
22 bargaining, the commission shall determine the prevailing
23 rate to be stated in the contract.

24 ~~(2) The commission may delegate the authority, with~~
25 ~~all applicable statutory restrictions, to award any contract~~

1 ~~covered by this section to the department or to a unit of~~
2 ~~local government."~~
