A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REVISE THE LAW
RELATING TO THE REMOVAL AND SALE OF ABANDONED VEHICLES TO
MAKE IT CLEAR THAT SALE, AFTER NOTICE, CUTS OFF THE RIGHTS
OF LIENHOLDERS: AMENDING SECTION 61-12-404, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-12-404, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-12-404. Sale of vehicle if not reclaimed. (1) If a
vehicle is not reclaimed as provided in 61-12-403 within 30
days after notification by registered-or certified mail or
prescribed publication, the sheriff of the county in which
it is located at the time it was taken into custody shall
sell it at public auction in the manner provided in
25-13-701 through 25-13-709.

(2) After any vehicle has been so sold, the former owner or person entitled to possession and the holder of any lien obtained prior to the sale has have no further right, title, claim, or interest in or to the vehicle."
