BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 39-5-303, MCA, is amended to read:

#39-5-303. Regulation of fees -- disapproval of
contract. (1) The fee charged by any employment agency for
its services must be based on a percentage of the projected
income of the applicant during for his first year of
employment. The percentage charged must be determined by the
agency and is not subject to disapproval by the director.

- (2) No applicant may be required to pay more than one fee per placement.
- 18 (3) No employment agency may impose a fee in excess of that agreed to in writing.
  - (4) A fee schedule must be printed on all contracts, and a copy of the contract containing the fee schedule must be given to each applicant prior to any discussion of available employment.
- 24 (5) Prior to using any contract in the transaction of 25 its business with applicants, each employment agency shall

- obtain the director's approval for the use of such contract.
- 2 The director shall disapprove any proposed contract which
- 3 either tends to be or is vague, deceitful, or
- 4 misrepresentative."
