A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING A COUNTY PLANNING BOARD ACTING AS A ZONING COMMISSION TO GIVE NOTICE OF AND CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ADOPTION OR AMENDMENT BE ZONING REGULATIONS: REDUCING FROM 30 DAYS TO 2 WEEKS THE PERIOD FOR PROTEST OF PROPOSED ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS; AND REDUCING FROM 30 DAYS TO 2 WEEKS THE TIME LIMIT FOR FORMAL ACTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON THE PROPOSED ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS; AMENDING SECTION 76-2-205. MCA.** 12

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 76-2-205, MCA, is amended to read: #76-2-205. Procedure for adoption of regulations and boundaries. The board of county commissioners or the county planning board acting as the Zoning commission shall observe the following procedures in the establishment or revision of boundaries for zoning districts and in the adoption or amendment of zoning regulations:

(1) Notice of a public hearing on the proposed zoning district boundaries and of regulations for the zoning district shall be published once-a-week-for--2--weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the county at least

- once, not less than 10 days prior to the hearing. The notice shall state:
- 3 (a) the boundaries of the proposed district:
- (b) the general character of the proposed zoning regulations:
- (c) the time and place of the public hearing;
- 7 (d) that the proposed zoning regulations are on file for public inspection at the office of the county clerk and 9 recorder.
- 10 (2) At the public hearing, the board of county 11 commissioners or the county planning board acting as the 12 zoning commission shall give the public an opportunity to be 13 heard regarding the proposed zoning district and 14 regulations.
- 15 (3) After the public hearing, the board of county 16 commissioners shall review the proposals of the planning 17 poard and shall make such revisions or amendments as it may 18 deem proper.
- 19 (4) The board of county commissioners may pass a 20 resolution of intention to create a zoning district and to adopt zoning regulations for the district. 21
- 22 (5) The board of county commissioners shall publish notice of passage of the resolution of intention once a week 23 24 for 2 weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the county. The notice shall state:

(a) the boundaries of the proposed district;

- (b) the general character of the proposed zoningregulations;
 - (c) that the proposed zoning regulations are on file for public inspection at the office of the county clerk and recorder;
 - (d) that for 39-days 2_Neeks after first publication of this notice, the board of county commissioners will receive written protests to the creation of the zoning district or to the zoning regulations from persons owning real property within the district whose names appear on the last completed assessment roll of the county.
 - (6) Within 30-days 2 weeks after the expiration of the protest pariod, the board of county commissioners may in its discretion adopt the resolution creating the zoning district and/or establishing the zoning regulations for the district; but if 40% of the freeholders within such district whose names appear on the last completed assessment roll shall have protested the establishment of the district or adoption of the regulations, the board of county commissioners shall not adopt the resolution and no further zoning resolution shall be proposed for the district for a period of 1 year.**
