(1) County bonds for any purpose other than those enumerated in 7-7-2221 and 7-7-2311 may not be issued unless authorized at a duly called special or general election at which the question of issuing such bonds is submitted to the registered electors of the county and approved as provided in 7-7-2237.

(2) No bond election may be called unless the board of county commissioners:

(a) initiates and adopts a resolution in accordance with the provisions of 7-7-2227; or

(b) receives a petition, delivered and certified by 22 the election administrator, asking that such election be held and the question be submitted. The petition must be signed by at least 20% of the registered electors of the
