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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-2-121, MCA, is amended to read:

#20-2-121. Board of public education — powers and
duties. The board of public education shall:

- (1) effect an orderly and uniform system for teacher certification, specialist certification and for the issuance of an emergency authorization of employment by adopting the policies prescribed by 20-4-102 and 20-4-111;
- (2) consider the suspension or revocation of teacher or specialist certificates and appeals from the denial of teacher or specialist certification in accordance with the provisions of 20-4-110;
- 22 (3) administer and order the distribution of state 23 equalization aid in accordance with the provisions of 24 20-9-344;
 - (4) adopt and enforce policies to provide uniform

standards and regulations for the design, construction, and operation of school buses in accordance with the provisions of 20-10-111:

- 4 (5) approve or disapprove a reduction of the number of 5 hours in a district's school day in accordance with the 6 provisions of 20-1-302;
- 7 (6) adopt policies prescribing the conditions when 8 school may be conducted on Saturday and the types of 9 pupil-instruction-related days and approval procedure for 10 such days in accordance with the provisions of 20-1-303 and 11 20-1-304:
- 12 (7) adopt standards of accreditation and establish the 13 accreditation status of every school in accordance with the 14 provisions of 20-7-101 and 20-7-102;

1 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Equivalency of completion of secondary education. The superintendent of public instruction shall issue, in accordance with the policies of the board of public education, appropriate documentation certifying that an eligible applicant has satisfied requirements for equivalency of completion of secondary education. Equivalency of completion of secondary education must include satisfactory completion of a testing program or an external diploma program approved by the board of public education.

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NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. Section 2 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20, chapter 7, part 1, and the provisions of Title 20 apply to section 2.

THIRD READING MISSING

STATEMENT OF INTENT

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Senate Education and Cultural Resources Committee

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A statement of intent is required for this bill because it delegates rulemaking authority to the Board of Public Education to adopt rules for issuance of documents certifying equivalency of completion of secondary education.

While the Board has clearly delineated rulemaking authority to adopt standards of accreditation and establish the accreditation status of every school, its rulemaking authority has only been implied in the area of setting standards for documents which state that an eligible applicant has satisfied requirements for equivalency of completion of secondary education.

At the recommendation of the Administrative Code Committee, the Board requested legislation specifically providing the Board with the authority to adopt policies for the issuance of high school equivalency certificates and to direct the Superintendent of Public Instruction to issue those certificates.

The bill gives the Board the express rulemaking authority to adopt rules in the area of high school equivalency certificates. It is contemplated that:
