BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 19-4-804, MCA, is amended to read:

"19-4-804. Allowance for superannuation retirement.

(1) Upon superannuation retirement a member shall receive a retirement allowance consisting of a pension which, together with an annuity, provides a retirement allowance equal to one-sixtieth of his average final compensation multiplied by the number of years of creditable service.

(2) Any retired member may be employed as a part-time or substitute teacher in Montana and may earn, without loss of retirement benefits, the greater of an amount not to exceed the greater of:

(a) one-fourth one-third of the sum of his average final compensation and plus normal annual salary increases for TEACHING PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY the school DISTRICT,

STATE AGENCY, POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, or university unit that employed the member at the time of retirement; or

(b) one-fourth one-third of the median of the average final compensation for members retired during the preceding fiscal year as determined by the retirement board."
