BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-16-2205, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-16-2205. Authorization for mill levy for support of  
museums. (1) The board of county commissioners of any county  
owning or acquiring any such museum or collection of  
exhibits:

(a) may make an appropriation in its annual budget for  
the upkeep, care, maintenance, operation, and support  
thereof; and

(b) to meet and take care of such appropriation, may  
annually levy a tax of not to exceed ~~1-mill~~ 2-mills on each  
dollar of the taxable valuation of the property subject to  
taxation in the county.

(2) The levy shall be made at the same time as other  
levies are made for county and school purposes.

(3) The proceeds from the collection of such levy  
shall be kept in a special fund by the county treasurer and  
used solely for the purpose for which such levy was made."
