A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE MAXIMUM MILL LEVY FOR COUNTY LIBRARY SERVICES: PLACING A LIMITATION ON WHEN A LEVY MAY BE APPLIED TO MUNICIPAL PROPERTY FOR A JOINT CITY-COUNTY LIBRARY OR A LIBRARY THAT IS PART OF A 7 LIBRARY SYSTEM; AMENDING SECTION 22-1-304. MCA.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 22-1-304, MCA, is amended to read: "22-1-304. Tax levy -- special library fund -- bonds. (1) (a) The governing body of any city or county which has established a public library may levy in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied a special tax in the amount necessary to maintain adequate public library service, not to exceed 3 6 mills on the dollar, upon all property in such county which may be levied by the governing body of such county and not to exceed 4 1/2 mills on the dollar upon all property in such city which may be levied by the governing body of such city.

(b) (i) If a library is part of a library system pursuant to 22-1-402 or is part of a joint city-county library pursuant to 22-1-316, no levy may be made upon property in a municipality until the maximum levy has been

applied to all other property in the county.

- (2) The proceeds of such tax shall constitute a separate fund called the public library fund and shall not be used for any purpose except those of the public library.
- (3) No money shall be paid out of the public library fund by the treasurer of the city or county except by order or warrant of the board of library trustees.
- (4) Bonds may be issued by the governing body in the manner prescribed by law for the erection and equipment of public library buildings and the purchase of land therefor.*
