9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Designation of person to receive decedent's
11 warrants or paychecks -- reissuance. Any person employed by
12 a county may file with his appointing power a designation of
13 a person who, notwithstanding any other provision of law, is
14 entitled, on the death of the employee, to receive all
15 warrants or paychecks that would have been payable to the
16 decedent had he survived. The employee may change the
17 designation from time to time. A person so designated shall
18 claim such warrants or paychecks from the county clerk, and
19 on sufficient proof of identity, the county clerk shall
20 reissue the warrant or paycheck in the name of the
21 designated person and deliver the warrant or paycheck to the
22 designated person.
