BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 39-31-101, MCA, is amended to read:
#39-31-101. Policy. In order to promote public
business by removing certain recognized sources of strife
and unrest, it is the policy of the state of Montana to
encourage the practice and procedure of collective
bargaining to arrive at friendly adjustment of all disputes
between public employers and their employees. <u>Fundamental</u>
distinctions between private and public employment must be
recognized in interpreting this chapter.
