DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 232 increases the fee for a certified copy of a birth or death certificate.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) No additional cost will be incurred.
- 2) Number of current requests are 17,000 per year.
- 3) Reduction of appropriated general fund will be dollar for dollar.

FISCAL IMPACT:


No additional cost will be incurred for FY 84 or 85. This act will have a net effect of saving the general fund \$34,000 per year.
