BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-14-2601, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-14-2601. Petition to establish, alter, or abandon a county road. (1) Any 10, or a majority, of the freeholders of a road district taxable therein for road purposes may petition the board in writing to open, establish, construct, change, abandon, or discontinue any county road in the district.

- (2) When the road petitioned for is on the dividing line between two counties, the same procedure must be followed except that a copy of the petition must be presented to each board. The two boards shall act jointly.

"7-14-2617. Discontinuance of street not to affect
utility easements. The No vacation: abandonment: or other
alteration authorized by 7-14-2616 this part shall not
affect the right of any public utility to continue to
maintain its plant and equipment in any such county road:
street: or alley."

Section 4. Section 76-3-305. MCA, is amended to read:

#76-3-305. Vacation of plats — utility easements. (1)

Any plat prepared and recorded as herein provided may be vacated either in whole or in part as provided by 7-5-2501, 7-5-2502, subsections—(1)—and—(2)—of—7-14-2616, 7-14-2617, subsections (1) and (2) of 7-14-4114, and 7-14-4115, and upon such vacation the title to the streets and alleys of such vacated portions to the center thereof shall revert to the owners of the properties within the platted area adjacent to such vacated portions.

(2) However, when any poleline, pipeline, or any other

2 alley at the time of the reversion of the title thereto, the

public or private facility is located in a vacated street or

3 owner of said public or private utility facility shall have

4 an easement over the vacated land to continue the operation

and maintenance of the public utility facility."
