Section 1. Section 85-5-107, MCA, is amended to read:

"85-5-107. Record of daily distribution of water. Each
water commissioner must keep a daily record of the amount of
water distributed to each water user and must file a summary
of such record with the clerk of the court monthly ~~or~~
~~seasonally, at the discretion of the district judge~~ during
his term of service, showing in detail the total amount of
water distributed ~~each day~~ to each water user during such
month ~~or season~~ ~~daily~~ and the amount of cost therefor, based
upon the water commissioner's or commissioners' salary per
day ~~and other costs of the water commissioner approved by~~
~~the district judge~~, and the proportionate amount of water
distributed. When two or more water commissioners serve
under the same decree or decrees by order of the judge, they
may file a joint summary of their record with the clerk of
the court, or the chief commissioner, if one has been
