Senate Bill 284 provides for inclusion of information on candidates for designated offices in the Voter Information Pamphlet and specifies the format for the information.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1) Assume 3 candidates for each of the following offices: Western District U.S. Representative, Eastern District U.S. Representative, Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Auditor, Superintendent of Public Instruction, PSC District 2, PSC District 4 and PSC District 5.

2) Assume 3 candidates for each of the open seats on the Supreme Court.

3) Assume all candidates choose to participate in the candidate information section.

4) Assume a fee for participation of \$1,350.
