BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 13-25-203, MCA, is amended to read:

**13-25-203. Vacancy in office of United States senator

or representative. (1) If a vacancy occurs in the office of

United States senator or representative, the governor shall

immediately order an election to be held to fill the

vacancy, except as provided in subsection (3).

- (2) The election to fill the unexpired term shall be held within 90 days from the time the vacancy occurs, except that if the vacancy occurs 150 days or less before a primary election or between the primary and general elections in odd-numbered—years a year that is not a regular election year for that office, the election shall be held with the primary or general election.
- (3) If the vacancy occurs between the primary and general election in even-numbered years a year that is a

- regular election year for that office, the candidate elected

- 3 take office to fill the unexpired term.
