A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SPECIFICALLY SUB
MATHORIZING THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO ORDER AN CONTOUR

INDEPENDENT AUDIT OF A PUBLIC UTILITY; PROVIDING THAT THE LANKE

COST OF AN AUDIT SHALL BE BORNE BY THE PUBLIC UTILITY; AND

MUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION TO COMPEL THE PRODUCTION OF

INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR SUCH AUDIT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Independent audit. (1) The commission may order an independent audit of a public utility, to be paid for by the utility, if the commission considers an audit to be necessary to the performance of its regulatory duties.

- (2) For the purposes of conducting an audit pursuant to subsection (1), the commission may require, by order or subpoens, the production within this state of any:
 - (a) books;
- 20 (b) accounts;
- 21 (c) papers;
- 22 (d) records;
- 23 (e) verified copies of the material listed in 24 subsections (2)(a) through (2)(d); or
- 25 (f) any other pertinent information, including

1 information pertaining to the method used by the utility in 2 collecting requested information.

- (3) An order or subpoena issued pursuant to subsection
 (2) must be served in the same manner as a summons in a
 civil action in district court.
- 6 (4) This section applies to information kept by a 7 utility in any office or place within or without the state.
- 8 (5) The audit may be conducted by the commission or 9 under its direction by an independent accountant acceptable to the commission.
- Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 69, chapter 3, part 1, and the provisions of Title 69, chapter 14 3, apply to section 1.
