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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MUNTANA:

Section 1. Section 10-1-110, MCA, is amended to read: "10-1-110. Distinctive license plates for national quardsmen. [1] In addition-to lieu of the regular license plates prescribed by law, there may be issued to each active member of the Montana national quard distinctive license plates bearing the words "national quard" and "Montana". said plates to be numbered in sets of two with a different number following the letters "NG". Plates shall be furnished by the division of motor vehicles to the adjutant--generaly county ...treasurer and by him issued to the members of the active quard. The adjutant general shall inform-the-division of-motor-vehicles-of-each-set-so-issuedy-giving--the--number of--the--licensey--the--namey--unity-and-home-address-of-the member-to-whom-issuedy-and--shall--be--responsible--for--the recovery--of--said--plates--and-notification-to-the-division upon issue a certificate authorizing each active member of the national quard one set of such plates, and the member

shall surrender the plates upon becoming ineligible to use them. Plates so issued shall be placed or mounted on the vehicle over-the-requiar-license-plate and shall be removed upon sale or other disposition of the vehicle. Said distinctive plates shall be renewed every 5 years or when lost, destroyed, or damaged.
