"37-67-308. General qualifications of applicants for registration as land surveyor or land surveyor-in-training.
(1) To be eligible for admission to examination for land surveyor or land surveyor-in-training, an applicant must be of good character and reputation. The applicant shall submit five references with his application for registration as a land surveyor, three of which references shall be registered land surveyors having personal knowledge of his land surveying experience. In the case of an application for certification as a land surveyor-in-training, the applicant shall submit three references, one of whom shall be a registered land surveyor having personal knowledge of the applicant's land surveying experience.
