  - (5) (a) whenever the department has reasonable cause to believe a person is in possession of any diseased or parasitic bee or equipment or otherwise possesses any bee or equipment in violation of this part or rules adopted under it, the department may order a quarantine for not more than 30 days of the suspected bees or equipment and may require any person in possession of such bees or equipment to hold them under specified conditions until notified otherwise in writing by the department.
  - (b) The department shall release any quarantine or order to hold bees upon the failure to detect disease in any

official sample of bees as provided by department rules or on equipment and upon a finding that the bees and equipment are disease-free and are possessed in compliance with this part."

Section 3. Section 80-6-1105, MCA, is amended to read:

#80-6-1105. Alfalfa leaf-cutting bees -- inspection -certification -- fees. (1) No person may import, possess, or
control alfalfa leaf-cutting bees in the state of Montana
unless the bees are certified annually, as provided in this
section.

- (2) To certify bees, a person must file a completed application form provided by the department together with the certification fee prescribed by the department. The applicant must provide at least the following:
- (a) name and place of residence;
- 16 (b) the general location and number of bees to be
  17 registered; and
- 18 (c) other relevant information as may be required by
  19 department rule.
  - (3) After receipt of an application for certification, a sample of the total population of bees to be certified shall be selected by the department or its agent in a manner prescribed by the department. The sample shall be inspected for pathogens and parasites. If no pathogens or parasites in excess of certification standards are found, the sample

- (4) When the department has in its possession a completed application form, a certification fee, and a report that the sample is-disease-free meets certification standards, it may issue a certificate for the bees.
- (5) The department shall specify the date by which any applicant must apply for recertification the following year.

  Applications for recertification certification received after the date specified shall be assessed a penalty equal to 10% of the applicable certification fee but not exceeding \$50.00
- Section 4. Section 80-6-1107, MCA, is amended to read:

  \*80-6-1107. Restrictions on importing bees and equipment. (1) No bee may be imported into the state of Montana except under the provisions of this section.
