A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE AT LEAST 3  
YEARS OF RESIDENCY IN THE STATE OF MONTANA FOR ELIGIBILITY  
FOR THE POSITION OF INSTRUCTOR AT THE FIRE SERVICES TRAINING  
SCHOOL."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Residency requirement for professional  
staff. In order to assure familiarity with the types of fire  
service needs and logistics of the Montana forestry  
environment, applicants for the position of instructor at  
the fire services training school must have been a resident  
of this state for at least 3 years prior to submitting the  
application.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20,  
chapter 31, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 31,  
apply to section 1.
