INTRODUCED BY

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW ALL GRANDPARENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO SEEK VISITATION RIGHTS WITH THEIR GRANDCHILDREN; AMENDING SECTION 40-9-102, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 40-9-102, MCA, is amended to read:

"40-9-102. Grandparent visitation rights. (1) ~~if the father or mother of an unmarried child is deceased, the~~ the district court may grant to ~~the parents of the deceased~~ person one or both grandparents of a child reasonable visitation rights ~~with the child.~~

(2) Visitation rights granted under this section may be granted only upon a finding by the court, after a hearing, that the visitation would be in the best interest of the child.

(3) This section does not apply if the child has been adopted by a person other than a stepparent or a grandparent. Visitation rights granted under this section terminate upon the adoption of the child by a person other than a stepparent or a grandparent."
