 16 does interfere with the ability to discharge a firearm in a
 17 safe manner and who applies for a Class A-1, A-3, A-4, A-5,
 18 or A-6 license may receive certification for a license that:
 19 (a) allows the person to pursue, hunt, and tag any
 20 game permitted by the license; and
 21 (b) allows another person with the same class of
 22 license to shoot and kill in the presence of the licensee
 23 any game permitted by the license.

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW A PERSON 65 62 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO HAS A SPECIFIC DISABILITY THAT DOES NOT INTERFERE WITH THE SPORT OF HUNTING BUT DOES INTERFERE WITH THE ABILITY TO DISCHARGE A FIREARM TO RECEIVE CERTIFICATION FOR A GAME LICENSE THAT WILL ALLOW ANOTHER LICENSED HUNTER TO KILL THE GAME AUTHORIZED BY THE LICENSE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. License certificate for residents over ~~sixty-five~~ SIXTY-TWO with specific disabilities. (1) A resident 65 62 years of age or older who has a specific disability that is not severe enough to interfere with the sport of hunting but does interfere with the ability to discharge a firearm in a safe manner and who applies for a Class A-1, A-3, A-4, A-5, or A-6 license may receive certification for a license that:

(a) allows the person to pursue, hunt, and tag any game permitted by the license; and

(b) allows another person with the same class of license to shoot and kill in the presence of the licensee any game permitted by the license.

(2) For the purposes of this section, "specific

disability" means cataracts on the eyes or rheumatism of the hands or arms.

(3) To apply for and receive the certification authorized in subsection (1), the person shall:

(a) purchase the license from a game warden or employee of the department who is authorized to sell licenses; and

(b) in the presence of the warden or employee, sign a certificate that states:

(i) the person's specific disability; and

(ii) the name of the person or persons who will accompany the applicant to make the kill of any game permitted by the license.

(4) The person authorized in subsection (3) to witness the signing of the certificate and sell the license shall attach the certificate to the license.

Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 87, chapter 2, part 8, and the provisions of Title 87 apply to section 1.
