A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT FOR THE DESIGNATION OF

AREA AGENCIES FOR SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Designation of area agencies. (1) The department of social and rehabilitation services may designate as an area agency in a geographical area an entity that demonstrates its ability to:

- (a) develop and administer an area plan for a comprehensive and coordinated system of services; and
- (b) serve as the advocate and focal point for older
 persons in the planning and service area.
- 16 (2) Such an entity may be but is not limited to:
- 17 (a) an established office on aging that operates
 18 within the geographical area;
- 19 (b) an office or agency of a unit of general purpose
 20 local government, except a county welfare office or
 21 department;
- (c) any combination of such offices or units ofgeneral purpose local governments; or
- 24 (d) any other public or private nonprofit agency,
 25 except a regional or local agency of the state.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

SENATE BILL 404

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A statement of intent is necessary because this act gives the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services the authority to designate area Councils on Aging for senior citizen services. It is intended that the Department establish criteria for use by area agencies or entities who apply to be area agencies that set forth the administrative and services capabilities necessary for area agencies. The rules must be in conformance with applicable federal law but recognize community needs for community services.
