 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 39-51-2204, MCA, is amended to
 10 read:

11 "39-51-2204. Duration of benefits. (1) Any otherwise
 12 eligible individual shall be entitled during his benefit
 13 year to benefits for the total number of weeks appearing in
 14 the following table on the line which includes his ratio of
 15 total base period earnings to highest quarter base period
 16 earnings:

In compliance with a written request received February 18, , 19 83 , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate Bill 463 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 463 establishes an extended unemployment benefits duration program to be paid by Unemployment Insurance trust fund and to trigger on when the current insured unemployment rate equals or exceeds 4% and equals or exceeds 115% of the average for the corresponding 13 week period in the last 2 calendar years.

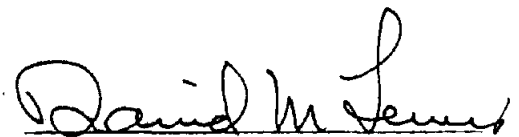
ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1) Assume regular EB program triggers on for 13 weeks each FY. Assume additional 13 week EB program will occur each FY under proposed bill.
- 2) Assume total EB payments of 35,000 for each EB program in FY84; 32,000 for each EB program in FY85.
- 3) Assume regular EB program state-share cost at 100% of first EB pay and 50% of all subsequent pays; assume additional 13 week extended duration program to be funded entirely by state Unemployment Insurance trust fund.
- 4) Assume average weekly benefit amount of \$138 in FY84 and \$150 in FY85.

FISCAL IMPACT:
