A RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA THAT THE

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION PROCEED WITH THE CAPITOL

RENOVATION PLAN THAT RETAINS THE SENATE CHAMBERS IN THEIR
PRESENT LOCATION.

WHEREAS, the Montana Supreme Court has decided the
 matter of Pat M. Goodover, State Senator, and Carroll A.
 Graham, State Senator, vs. the Department of Administration
et al., wherein the Department of Administration was
 enjoined against relocation of the Senate chambers until
 legislative consent has been obtained; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Supreme Court stated in its
 opinion that "the Montana State Senate, a distinguished,
 honorable, and independent arm of the legislative body, has
 the right to determine where it will sit"; and

WHEREAS, the time for making the decision on the
 location of the Senate chambers and letting bids for
 renovation of the State Capitol is propitious in view of the
 upcoming construction season and in the interest of saving
 time and money; and

WHEREAS, there is an alternate plan for Capitol
 renovation that was proposed during the meeting of the 47th

Legislature which retains the Senate chambers in their
 present location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
 MONTANA:

That the Department of Administration is directed to
 proceed with the alternate plan for Capitol renovation as
 proposed during the meeting of the 47th Legislature, which
 plan retains the Senate chambers in their present location.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State
 deliver a copy of this resolution to the Director of the
 Department of Administration.
