12	Section 1. Section 10-2-206, MCA, is amended to read:
13	*10-2-206. Enforcement of preference. [1] Any person
14	entitled to preference in 10-2-201 through 10-2-206 who has
15	applied for any appointment or employment upon public works
16	of the state of Montana or any county and city thereof or in
17	any public department of the state and who has been denied
18	employment or appointment and feels that the spirit of
19	10-2-201 through 10-2-206 has been violated and that such
20	person is in fact qualified physically and mentally and
21	possesses business capacity, competency, and education to
22	discharge the duties of the position applied for may
23	petition by verified petition the district court of the
24	state of Montana in the county in which the work is to be
25	performed. The petition shall set forth the facts of the

1 application, qualifications, competency, and such person's 2 honorable discharge or other qualifications warranting the 3 applicant to preference under 10-2-201 through 10-2-206. Upon filing of such petition, any judge in the court shall 4 issue an order to show cause to the appointing authority 5 6 directing the appointing authority to appear in the court at a specified time and place, not less than 5 or more than 10 7 days after the filing of the verified petition, to show в 9 cause, if any exists, why the veteran or person entitled to 10 preference should not be employed by the appointing 11 authority. The district court has jurisdiction upon the proper showings to issue its order directing and ordering 12 the appointing authority to comply with this law in giving 13 14 the preference provided for. 15 121 In ordering relief under subsection (1), a court 16 may not grant an award of backpay." 17 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date 18 applicability. (1) This act is effective on passage and 19 approval.

(2) This act applies only to positions that become
open for employment after the effective date of this act.

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
