10	Section 1. Section 61-10-203, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"61-10-203. Alternative gross weight fees on truck
12	trailer combinations. (1) In addition to other fees for the
13	licensing of vehicles, there may be paid and collected
14	annually instead of the fees provided in 61-10-201, for each
15	motortruck or truck tractor, based upon the maximum combined
16	gross loaded weight of a truck tractor with a semitrailer, a
17	truck tractor with a semitrailer and a full trailer, a
18	motortruck and a trailer, or a motortruck and trailers, as
19	set by the licensee in his application, the following fees:
