5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR  
6 VIOLATION OF THE BRUCELLOSIS VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
9                    Section 1. Penalty. A person convicted of violating  
10 this part shall be fined not more than \$500, be imprisoned  
11 in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months, or  
12 both.  
13                    Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
14 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 81,  
15 chapter 2, part 8, and the provisions of Title 81, chapter  
16 2, part 8, apply to section 1.
