2 INTRODUCTION BY O'CONNELL

4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING CARRYING  
5 PASSENGERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE IN A TRUCK BOX NOT FULLY  
6 ENCLOSED."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9        Section 1. Enclosed truck box required -- when. A  
10 person may not operate any truck, including a pickup, if the  
11 box or rear cargo space is occupied by persons under 18  
12 years of age unless the box or rear cargo space is fully  
13 enclosed at bottom, top, front, rear, and sides by a floor  
14 and a topper, camper, or other roof and walls to assure that  
15 passengers cannot easily jump, fall, or be thrown out.

16        Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
17 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61,  
18 chapter 8, part 3, and the provisions of Title 61 apply to  
19 section 1.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Enclosed truck box required -- when. A  
10 person may not operate any truck, including a pickup, AT A  
11 SPEED IN EXCESS OF 25 MILES PER HOUR, if the box or rear  
12 cargo space is occupied by persons under 18 years of age  
13 unless the box or rear cargo space is fully enclosed at  
14 bottom, top, front, rear, and sides by a floor and a topper,  
15 camper, or other roof and walls to assure that passengers  
16 cannot easily jump, fall, or be thrown out.

17 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
18 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61,  
19 chapter 8, part 3, and the provisions of Title 61 apply to  
20 section 1.
