 2    INTRODUCED BY PECK

 4    A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE A MONTHLY  
 5    SALARY OF \$200 FOR EACH LEGISLATOR BETWEEN SESSIONS, LESS AN  
 6    AMOUNT FOR EACH DAY SPENT ON AUTHORIZED COMMITTEE BUSINESS  
 7    FOR WHICH THE LEGISLATOR IS OTHERWISE PAID AS PROVIDED BY  
 8    LAW; AMENDING SECTIONS 5-1-104 AND 5-2-302, MCA; AND  
 9    PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

 11    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12            Section 1. Section 5-1-104, MCA, is amended to read:  
 13            "5-1-104. Compensation and expenses. Commissioners are  
 14    entitled to the same compensation and expenses as provided  
 15    to members of the legislature in 5-2-302 ~~5-2-302(1)~~ while  
 16    attending commission meetings or carrying out the official  
 17    duties of the commission."

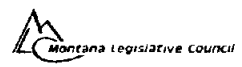
18            Section 2. Section 5-2-302, MCA, is amended to read:  
 19            "5-2-302. Compensation and expenses when legislature  
 20    not in session. (1) When the legislature is not in session,  
 21    members of the legislative council, legislative  
 22    subcommittees, and select and interim committees, while  
 23    engaged in authorized committee business, are entitled to:  
 24            ~~f1~~(a) a mileage allowance as provided in 2-18-503;  
 25            ~~f2~~(b) expenses as provided in 2-18-501 and 2-18-502;

1    and  
 2            ~~f3~~(c) a salary equal to one full day's pay at the  
 3    rate of a classified state employee, described in 5-2-301  
 4    for each 24-hour period of time (from midnight to midnight),  
 5    or portion thereof, spent away from home on authorized  
 6    committee business. However, if time spent for business  
 7    other than authorized committee business results in  
 8    lengthening a legislator's stay away from home into an  
 9    additional 24-hour period, he may not be compensated for the  
 10    additional day.

11            (2) When the legislature is not in session, each  
 12    member is entitled to a salary of \$200 a month, less \$6.67  
 13    for each day of the month the member is paid as provided in  
 14    subsection (1)(c)."

15            NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is  
 16    effective July 1, 1985.
