 8    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9            Section 1.    Section 20-25-312, MCA, is amended to read:

10           "20-25-312.    Motor vehicle regulation -- enforcement of  
 11    regulations -- appeals. (1) The regents may authorize the  
 12    president of each unit to:

13           (a) assess fees ~~not--to--exceed--\$10-per-quarter~~ for  
 14    parking on campus;

15           (b) assess fines in accordance with a published  
 16    schedule for violations of motor vehicle or parking  
 17    regulations of each unit in an amount not to exceed \$10 per  
 18    offense;

19           (c) order the removal of vehicles parked in violation  
 20    of motor vehicle regulations of each unit at the expense of  
 21    the violator;

22           (d) establish a system of appeals at each unit  
 23    concerning parking violations;

24           (e) withhold the amount of any unpaid parking fine  
 25    from any amount owing any student, employee, or faculty

1    member, subject to the concurrence of the state auditor  
 2    under the provisions of 17-4-105;

3           (f) prohibit a student from registering if said  
 4    student has unpaid parking assessments or fines outstanding  
 5    resulting from on-campus motor vehicle or parking violations  
 6    within the previous year.

7           (2) The proceeds from fines and fees collected shall  
 8    be remitted to the unit at which collections are made to be  
 9    used for appropriate maintenance and construction of parking  
 10    facilities and for traffic control."

RESPECTIVE STUDENT GOVERNING BODY; AMENDING SECTION

(b) assess fines in accordance with a published

the violator;

(d) establish a system of appeals at each unit  
concerning parking violations;

(e) withhold the amount of any unpaid parking fine  
from any amount owing any student, employee, or faculty  
member, subject to the concurrence of the state auditor  
under the provisions of 17-4-105;

(f) prohibit a student from registering if said  
student has unpaid parking assessments or fines outstanding  
resulting from on-campus motor vehicle or parking violations  
within the previous year.

(2) The proceeds from fines and fees collected shall  
be remitted to the unit at which collections are made to be  
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(b) assess fines in accordance with a published schedule for violations of motor vehicle or parking regulations of each unit in an amount not to exceed \$10 per offense;

(c) order the removal of vehicles parked in violation

of motor vehicle regulations of each unit at the expense of the violator;

(d) establish a system of appeals at each unit concerning parking violations;

(e) withhold the amount of any unpaid parking fine from any amount owing any student, employee, or faculty member, subject to the concurrence of the state auditor under the provisions of 17-4-105;

(f) prohibit a student from registering if said student has unpaid parking assessments or fines outstanding resulting from on-campus motor vehicle or parking violations within the previous year.

(2) The proceeds from fines and fees collected shall be remitted to the unit at which collections are made to be used for appropriate maintenance and construction of parking facilities and for traffic control."
