4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOCATING INDIRECT  
5 COST REIMBURSEMENTS OF RESEARCH GRANTS RECEIVED BY THE  
6 UNIVERSITY SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

7  
8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Allocation of indirect cost reimbursement  
10 for university system research grants. Funds designated as  
11 reimbursement for indirect costs of a research grant  
12 received by the Montana university system or any of its  
13 units are allocated to subfunds of the university current  
14 fund, as provided in 17-2-102, as follows:

15 (1) 50% to the designated subfund, to be allocated to  
16 the unit receiving the grant for the purpose of supporting  
17 research; and

18 (2) 50% to the unrestricted subfund.

19 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
20 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20,  
21 chapter 25, part 4, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter  
22 25, apply to section 1.

23 Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective July  
24 1, 1985.

In compliance with a written request received January 31, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 112 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


House Bill 112 provides that 50% of funds designated as reimbursement for indirect costs of research grants received by the Montana University System be allocated to the designated subfund to support research and 50% be allocated to the unrestricted subfund.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Indirect cost reimbursements (ICR) will continue to offset General Fund support of the Montana University System's current unrestricted fund.
2. The current appropriation of 85% of ICR to support the current unrestricted fund will decrease to 50%.
3. There will be no decrease in requests for General Fund support for research programs at the Montana University System.
