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 6    A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL  
 7    LABORATORIES TO REPORT CANCER DATA TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
 8    HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES; AMENDING SECTION  
 9    50-15-703, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE RULEMAKING  
 10    EFFECTIVE DATE."

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12    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13            Section 1. Section 50-15-703, MCA, is amended to read:

14            "50-15-703. Duty to report tumors. A hospital that  
 15    provides to any person medical services relating to a tumor  
 16    designated as reportable by the department or a clinical  
 17    laboratory, as defined in 50-5-101, that is not owned or  
 18    operated by a hospital and that provides laboratory services  
 19    relating to such a tumor shall make available to the  
 20    department all medical and personal information and  
 21    laboratory results relevant to that person's treatment and  
 22    condition on forms provided by the department."

23            NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any  
 24    existing authority of the department of health and  
 25    environmental sciences to make rules on the subject of the

1    provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this  
 2    act.

3            NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective dates. Section 2  
 4    and this section are effective on passage and approval, but  
 5    rules adopted pursuant to section 2 may not be made  
 6    effective until October 1, 1985.
