### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 117 would provide \$40 a month to each legislator during the interim between regular legislative sessions as reimbursement for their legislative expenses.

### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. Payments would be made only for complete months not in session.
- The legislature is not in regular session for 20 months normally. In the case of the 1987 biennium, 9 months would be covered in FY 86 and 8 months in FY87. Thereafter, 12 months would be covered in the first year of the biennium and 8 months in the second year.
