 5 EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION TO GUARANTEE CERTAIN RIGHTS AND
 6 SAFEGUARDS TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES IN ORDER TO BE RECOGNIZED AS
 7 THE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
 8 PURPOSES; GIVING THE BOARD OF PERSONNEL APPEALS JURISDICTION
 9 TO HEAR AND DECIDE DISPUTES INVOLVING THESE RIGHTS AND
 10 SAFEGUARDS; AMENDING SECTION 39-31-206, MCA; AND PROVIDING
 11 AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 Section 1. Section 39-31-206, MCA, is amended to read:

15 "39-31-206. Labor organization to guarantee certain
16 rights and safeguards prior to certification or recognition.

17 (1) Certification or recognition as an exclusive
18 representative shall be extended or continued, as the case
19 may be, only to a labor or employee organization the written
20 bylaws of which provide for and guarantee the following
21 rights and safeguards and whose practices conform to such
22 rights and safeguards as:

23 (1)(a) provisions are made for democratic organization
24 and procedures;

25 (2)(b) elections are conducted pursuant to adequate

1 standards and safeguards;
 2 (3)(c) controls are provided for the regulation of
 3 officers and agents having fiduciary responsibility to the
 4 organization; and
 5 (4)(d) requirements exist for maintenance of sound
 6 accounting and fiscal controls, including annual audits.
 7 (2) The board shall hear and decide all disputes
 8 arising under subsection (1)."
 9 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. This act is
 10 effective on passage and approval.
