Description of Proposed Legislation:

Transfer responsibility for Capitol grounds maintenance from the Department of Administration to the Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks.

Assumptions:

The proposed legislation officially transfers the Capitol building and grounds maintenance responsibilities to the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks from the Department of Administration. The 48th Legislature transferred the budget to Fish, Wildlife and Parks so there is no fiscal impact on the current budget proposal before the 49th Legislature.


