 9 SECTION 50-18-104, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE

 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Section 50-18-104, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "50-18-104. Serological test for syphilis. (1) The
 15 department of health and environmental sciences shall
 16 approve a standard serological test for syphilis. It shall
 17 also approve laboratories which may make such tests.

18 (2) On request the department shall make laboratory
 19 tests required by this chapter, ~~without charge.~~

20 (3) The department shall destroy the results of a test
 21 if an erroneous report is made."

22 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
 23 existing authority of the department of health and
 24 environmental sciences to make rules on the subject of the
 25 provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this

1 act.

2 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is
 3 effective on passage and approval.
