 6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CONFORM THE TIME
 7 LIMIT WITHIN WHICH A PREMARITAL SEROLOGICAL TEST PERFORMED
 8 OUTSIDE OF MONTANA MUST BE PERFORMED TO THAT REQUIRED FOR
 9 SUCH TESTS PERFORMED WITHIN MONTANA; AMENDING SECTION
 10 40-1-205, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Section 40-1-205, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "40-1-205. Certificates from other states or for
 15 military personnel -- when acceptable. Certificate forms
 16 provided by other states having comparable laws will be
 17 accepted for persons who have received a standard
 18 serological test outside of Montana if such tests are
 19 performed not more than ~~20-days~~ 6 months before the issuance
 20 of a marriage license. Certificates provided by the United
 21 States armed forces will be accepted for military personnel
 22 if such certificates are signed by a medical officer
 23 commissioned in the United States armed forces or United
 24 States public health service and the certificates state the
 25 examinations are standard serological tests and were

1 performed not more than ~~20-days~~ 6 months before the issuance
 2 of the marriage license."

3 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
 4 existing authority of the department of health and
 5 environmental sciences to make rules on the subject of the
 6 provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this
 7 act.

8 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is
 9 effective on passage and approval.
