LO	Section 1. Section 20-9-204, MCA, is amended to read:

L 2	and calling for bids. (1) It is unlawful for any trustee to:
13	(a) have any pecuniary interest, either directly or

15	capacity or by the board of trustees of which he is a

17	(b) be employed in any capacity by the school district

19	(2) For the purposes of subsection (1):
20	(a) "pecuniary interest" does not include holding an

(ii) investments or deposits in financial institutions

which are in the business of loaning or receiving money whe
such investments or deposits are made on a rotating o
ratable basis among financial institutions in the communit
or when there is only one financial institution in th
community; or
(iii) contracts for professional services other tha

salaried services or for maintenance or repair services or 7 8 supplies when the services or supplies are not reasonably 9 available from other sources if the interest of any board member and a determination of such lack of availability are 10 entered in the minutes of the board meeting at which the 11 12 contract is considered.

(3) Whenever the estimated cost of any building, furnishing, repairing, or other work for the benefit of the district, or purchasing of supplies for the district, or providing professional services for the district exceeds the sum of \$7,500, the work, done-or-the purchase, made-shatt-be or service must be done by contract. Each such contract must be let to the lowest responsible bidder after advertisement for bids. Such advertisement shall be published in the newspaper which will give notice to the largest number of people of the district as determined by the trustees. Such advertisement shall be made once each week for 2 consecutive weeks and the second publication shall be made not less than 5 days or more than 12 days before consideration of bids. A

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contract not let pursuant to this section shall be void.

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- (4) Whenever bidding is required, the trustees shall award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, except that the trustees may reject any or all bids.
- (5) Nothing in this section shall require the board of trustees to let a contract for any routine and regularly performed maintenance or repair project or service which can be accomplished by district staff whose regular employment with such school district is related to the routine performance of maintenance for such district."
