BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-9-405, MCA, is amended to read:
"61-9-405. Windshields to be unobstructed and equipped
with wipers. (1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle
with any sign, poster, or other nontransparent material upon
the front windshield, side wings, or side or rear windows of
such vehicle which obstructs the driver's clear view of the
highway or any intersecting highway.

(2) No person may operate a motor vehicle with reflective or darkening material on the front windshield or side or rear windows that prevents other persons from seeing into the driver's portion of the vehicle.

(2)(3) The windshield on every motor vehicle shall be equipped with a device for clearing rain, snow, or other moisture from the windshield, which device shall be so constructed as to be controlled or operated by the driver of the vehicle.

(3)(4) Every windshield wiper upon a motor vehicle
