Section 1. Section 18-4-313, MCA, is amended to read: "18-4-313. Contracts -- terms, extensions, and time limits. (1) Unless otherwise provided by law, no contract, lease, or rental agreement for supplies or services may be made for a longer period than 3 years; however, the department may contract for the lease or purchase of telecommunications equipment and systems, and processing equipment, and data processing management information systems for a period not to exceed 10 years. A contract, lease, or rental agreement may be extended or renewed, notwithstanding the time limits stated in this section, if the terms of the extension or renewal, if any, are included in the solicitation and funds are available for the first fiscal period at the time of the agreement. Payment and performance obligations for succeeding fiscal periods are subject to the availability and appropriation of
