BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-5-412, MCA, is amended to read:

"23-5-412. Bingo prizes. Bingo prizes must be in may be paid in either tangible personal property only and not in money, or cash, stocks, bonds, evidences of indebtedness, or other intangible personal property and must but may not exceed the value of \$100 for each individual bingo award. The price for an individual bingo card shall may not exceed 50 cents. It shall be unlawful to, in any manner, combine any awards so as to increase the ultimate value of such award."
