In compliance with a written request received January 16, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for H.B. 185 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 185 requires the Department of Highways to erect signs indicating routes to Postsecondary Vocational-Technical Centers.

ASSUMPTIONS:


1. Butte, Great Falls, and Billings would require 2 signs each. Helena and Missoula would require 4 signs, for a total of 14 signs.
2. Cost of fabrication and erection of each sign is \$537.

FISCAL IMPACT ON STATE SPECIAL REVENUE:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS:

Signs are refaced every seven years. This cost is currently estimated at \$207 per sign, or a total of \$2,898.

8    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9            Section 1. Vocational-technical center signs --  
10    location -- specifications. (1) The department shall  
11    design, construct, and erect appropriate signs indicating  
12    access routes to each postsecondary vocational-technical  
13    center designated in 20-7-311.

14           (2) The department shall locate each sign at the  
15    intersection or exit on the federal-aid highway system  
16    offering the nearest or the most practicable route to the  
17    postsecondary vocational-technical center concerned.

18           (3) The style, size, and color of the signs must be  
19    consistent with the specifications required for other  
20    informational or directional signs installed on the  
21    federal-aid highway system.

22           Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
23    intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 60,  
24    chapter 2, part 2, and the provisions of Title 60 apply to  
25    section 1.

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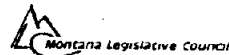
