In compliance with a written request received <u>January 16</u>, 19<u>85</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>H.B. 197</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 197 would increase the total amount of benefits that may be paid to a volunteer firefighter's surviving spouse or dependent child.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There would be no fiscal impact. Benefits are set by 19-12-404(2A) M.C.A. This states that benefits are set on 95% of growth of the assets in the fund. The proposed legislation would allow the total amount of benefits to rise to \$4,000 per year from \$2,000 but the increase would only materialize if the growth of the fund allowed benefits to total more than \$2,000.
