4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO  
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION FROM  
6 THE RENEWABLE RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT FOR EMERGENCY  
7 ASSISTANCE TO INSTALL THE THERRIAULT CREEK SIPHON IN THE  
8 GLEN LAKE IRRIGATION DISTRICT."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Appropriation. An amount of \$150,000 is  
12 appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources and  
13 Conservation from the renewable resource development account  
14 created within the state special revenue fund established in  
15 17-2-102 to be used for a grant to the Glen Lake irrigation  
16 district for the purpose of installing the Therriault Creek  
17 siphon. The grant is to be administered under the renewable  
18 resource development program and must be made before June  
19 30, 1987, or the money will revert to the renewable resource  
20 development account. Upon an application for the grant by  
21 the Glen Lake irrigation district, the Department of Natural  
22 Resources and Conservation must within 180 days make the  
23 grant, provided all conditions have been met. Any funds not  
24 used for the installation of the siphon must be returned to  
25 the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation for

1 deposit into the renewable resource development account.  
2 Section 2. Conditions of the grant. Disbursement of  
3 funds under this act may be made only after:  
4 (1) the project has been authorized by other financial  
5 sponsors, if any;  
6 (2) initial funding from other sources, if any, has  
7 been committed for construction; and  
8 (3) an agreement between the Department of Natural  
9 Resources and Conservation and the applicant has been  
10 executed governing the administration and disposal of funds.
