A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO
THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION FROM
THE RENEWABLE RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT FOR EMERGENCY
ASSISTANCE TO INSTALL THE THERRIAULT CREEK SIPHON IN THE
GLEN LAKE IRRIGATION DISTRICT."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. An amount of \$150,000 is appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation from the renewable resource development account created within the state special revenue fund established in 17-2-102 to be used for a grant to the Glen Lake irrigation district for the purpose of installing the Therriault Creek siphon. The grant is to be administered under the renewable resource development program and must be made before June 30, 1987, or the money will revert to the renewable resource development account. Upon an application for the grant by the Glen Lake irrigation district, the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation must within 180 days make the grant, provided all conditions have been met. Any funds not used for the installation of the siphon must be returned to the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation for



Section 2. Conditions of the grant. Disbursement of funds under this act may be made only after:

{1} the project has been authorized by other financial sponsors, if any;

(2) initial funding from other sources, if any, has been committed for construction; and

(3) an agreement between the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation and the applicant has been executed governing the administration and disposal of funds.
