BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 1-1-216, MCA, is amended to read: "1-1-216. Legal holidays and business days. (1) The following are legal holidays in the state of Montana:
(a) Each Sunday;
(b) New Year's Day, January 1;
(c) Lincoln's Birthday, February 12;
(d) Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in February;
(e) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
(f) Independence Day, July 4;
(g) Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
tht--Cotumbus-Bayt-the-second-Monday-in-Eetober;
tit (h) Veterans' Day, November 11; $^{\prime}$
tjt(i) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
(j) the fourth Friday in November, the day following

(k) Christmas Day, December 25;
(1) State general election day.
(2) If any of the above-enumerated holidays (except Sunday) fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday. All other days are business days."

Section 2. Section 20-25-306, MCA, is amended to read:
"20-25-306. Designation of holidays by board of regents. (1) The board of regents of higher education may designate the following business days as holidays for all employees of the university system in exchange for the same number of legal holidays enumerated in 1-1-216:
fat--the-Friday-fotłowing-Thanksgiving;
fbt(a) the Monday before Christmas Day or New Year's Day if either holiday falls on Tuesday; and
tef(b) the Friday after Christmas Day or New Year's Day if either holiday falls on Thursday.
(2) A full-time employee who is scheduled for a day off on a day that is designated as a holiday under subsection (1) is entitled to receive another day off with pay during the same pay period of the designated holiday or as scheduled by the employee and his supervisor in addition to the employee's requarly scheduled days off provided the employee is in a pay status on his last regularly scheduled working day immediately before the holiday or on his first

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1 regularly scheduled working day immediately after the2 holiday. Part-time employees receive pay for the designated3 holiday on a prorated basis according to rules adopted by4 the department of administration or appropriate
5 administrative officer under 2-18-604."
